
Straps and Struts





Reinforcing

Reinforcing straps support the messenger bolt at locations of heavier than normal loading stress, such as long spans.

Features


- Used with cable suspension clamps
- Lower hole fits over the messenger bolt and the top end is fastened to pole with a lag screw

Wall


Features

- J7692 is formed from 1 7/32 x 15/64" steel
- J7692 is used to terminate strand at a right angle to the building wall
- A wire rope thimble is recommended to protect the strand when using a J7692 wall strap
- J7695 and J7696 terminate strand at the building corners
- J7695 and J7696 are made of 1 3/8 x 11/32" steel with a forged thimbleye
- J7695 has 2 and the J7696 has 3 9/16" diameter holes spaced 8" from center to center

Pole/Guy Spreaders
